Mr. Love is currently President and Chief Executive Officer of the Dallas-Fort Worth Hospital Council which promotes collaboration, cooperation, and advocacy on behalf of its 90 member hospitals. The Hospital Council also has approximately 100 Associate Members (business and industry), including prominent accounting, legal and consulting firms. The primary mission is to drive evidence-based improvement in patient care and health equity in North Texas.

He was the United Nations Association Award Winner in 2018 for Global Goals. He served as 2015 Chair for the Conference of Metropolitan and Regional Hospitals Association in the United States. He received the 2020 D CEO's Lifetime Achievement Award. He also received the Dallas Medical Society's Millard J. and Robert L. Health Award for a non-physician providing outstanding leadership to the community.

He previously served on the Children at Risk Board for North Texas, Southwest Region Board for the American Heart Association, Chair for the March of Dimes Walk for Babies Campaign and Mothers Against Drunk Driving Dallas. He serves on the Southwest Transplant Alliance for organ transplants; Cure Glaucoma Foundation Advisory Board; North Texas Eye Research Institute; the Metropolitan YMCA Board of Directors; the Board of Directors of Prism Health North Texas and the Greater Irving-Las Colinas Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors.

Mr. Love has worked in healthcare management for over 50 years. He has demonstrated leadership in tax exempt, investor-owned, specialty and private hospitals in operations, finance, and corporate governance. Prior to joining the Dallas-Fort Worth Hospital Council, Mr. Love was Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of a Fortune 500 healthcare company that owned over 50 hospitals and managed approximately 200 facilities in the United States

Brad Watson is senior director of community affairs at Vistra, a leading Fortune 500 integrated retail electricity and power generation company based in Irving, Texas, providing essential resources for customers, commerce, and communities. Vistra combines an innovative, customer-centric approach to retail with safe, reliable, diverse, and efficient power generation. The company brings its products and services to market in 20 states and the District of Columbia, including six of the seven competitive wholesale markets in the U.S. Serving approximately 4 million residential, commercial, and industrial retail customers with electricity and natural gas, Vistra is one of the largest competitive electricity providers in the country and offers over 50 renewable energy plans. The company is also the largest competitive power generator in the U.S. with a capacity of approximately 37,000 megawatts powered by a diverse portfolio, including natural gas, nuclear, solar, and battery energy storage facilities.

Watson oversees the company's community relations efforts with local governments, chambers of commerce and community groups as well as the Vistra Corporate Giving Policy.

Vistra has established a leading role in the energy transition with Vistra Zero, its zero-carbon generation portfolio. With a robust pipeline of development projects that Watson and the Community Affairs team he leads assist in supporting, Vistra expects to have at least 7,300 MW of zero-carbon generation online by 2026 across Texas, California, and Illinois.

Prior to joining Luminant in April 2013, Watson worked as a television journalist. In his 34 years with WFAA-TV, the ABC affiliate in Dallas-Fort Worth, Watson anchored the station's top-rated newscasts from 1992 to 2000. He covered major stories across Texas, the nation, Mexico, and Latin America. His later assignments included covering Dallas city government, state government and politics and hosting the station's "Inside Texas Politics" program.

He currently is Chairman of the Board for the Irving-Las Colinas Chamber of Commerce.

Watson graduated from Iowa State University with degrees in journalism and political science.

George Moubayed is the chief sustainability and strategy officer of Caterpillar Inc. Sustainability is an important focus area of Caterpillar's long-term strategy for profitable growth, and this role further enhances the advancement of product solutions to support Caterpillar's customers during the energy transition and help them achieve their climate-related objectives by geography, application, and specific customer need.

Moubayed is also a senior vice president of Caterpillar Inc., responsible for the Enterprise Strategy Division. He oversees the continued execution of Caterpillar's strategy for long-term profitable growth, leveraging the Operating & Execution Model as Caterpillar continues introducing innovative products and services to make its customers more successful.

Prior to being appointed senior vice president of the Enterprise Strategy Division in January 2023, Moubayed served as vice president and general manager for load and haul products in Resource Industries. Before joining the load and haul products group, he was the vice president of aftermarket solutions in Resource Industries.

Moubayed joined Caterpillar in 1997 as a marketing representative and was responsible for machine and aftermarket sales and dealer support and development in Canada. He became the region manager for North America and Europe aftermarket sales and later served as Canada district manager and country manager.
